Primary Responsibilities:

- Ability to recognize discrepancy in Bills of Material vs. prints/work instructions.
- Ability to recognize and report any non-conforming product.
- Accountable for the accurate product and number of product pieces being used in each build.
- Miscellaneous: Other Duties as Assigned
